	<p>Personal protection equipment</p> <p>1. one Canadian-approved personal flotation device or lifejacket of appropriate size for each person on board</p>
	<p>2. one buoyant heaving line of not less than 15 m in length</p>
	<p>Distress equipment</p> <p>3. a watertight flashlight</p> <p>OR</p> <p>3 Canadian approved flares of Type A, B or C</p> <p>This equipment (2, 3) is not mandatory if all people on board are wearing a Canadian-approved flotation device of appropriate size.</p>
	<p>Navigation equipment</p> <p>4. a sound-signalling device or a sound-signalling appliance</p>
	<p>5. navigation lights that meet the applicable standards set out in the Collision Regulations if the pleasure craft is operated after</p>

	sunset and before sunrise or in periods of restricted visibility
